The aims of the conference:

- to make known widely the "Nonformal for All" course for teachers and specialists who work with inclusive groups of students and who wish to improve their skills in planning, organizing and implementing games and nonformal methods which include all the children, regardless of their special needs. This nonformal inclusive strategy opposes the segregation because although the integrated children with special needs have the necessary psychological and pedagogical aid in order to cover the curricula, they are usually avoided or even rejected from school games, social events and any other extracurricular activity which take place at school.

- to raise awareness on the good practices guide "Inclusive Games and Nonformal Activities For All", which illustrates the results of an international cooperation in the area of implementing inclusive nonformal strategies. The guide contains a detailed description of objectives, results, the work methodology and the games & nonformal activities results. These are developed in the project's activities and adapted for inclusive groups of students with mental, physical, behavior disabilities, TSA, ADHD or to groups of minority, multilingual, multicultural and migrants.

- to disseminate project results and impact and exchange good practices within the specialists network and stakeholders.
